Expectations of Participants

All participants have the responsibility to assist in the setting and maintaining of acceptable and safe standards of behaviour. Supervising staff members, houseparents and volunteers have a responsibility to parents and schools to provide a safe and caring environment to all participants.

1 Alcohol and cigarettes are not permitted for any participant. The possession of other illegal substances is also prohibited.

2 It is anticipated that workshops will be intensive and participants are expected to attend all scheduled events, both day and night, during the residency. Only exceptions due to illness will be considered.

3 Participants are not allowed to leave the school or workshop areas unless outside activities have been arranged as part of the program. Day Participants are expected to attend all scheduled daytime events during the residency and are welcome to join in the evening activities. Additional costs may apply to some evening activities including dinner. Day participants are to inform supervisors if attending and when leaving after an evening activity.

4 Dormitory lights will be turned out and participants asked to be quiet after 10.00pm each evening. Non-resident participants are to leave after the workshop or days activity unless otherwise specified.

5 The accommodation at Churchie is dormitory-style with one to several beds per room and participants will have access to kitchen facilities and a common room with television.

6 Supervising staff and houseparents will regularly check rooms and are there to help with any problems. Participants are not to be in any room other than their own. Note that the common rooms are available for recreational purposes.

7 Participants will not be allowed visits from friends and family during the week of Art Camp without permission from Flying Arts staff and visitors are not permitted to stay over at Churchie during Art Camp under any circumstances. Friends and relatives are invited to come along to the final exhibition on Saturday.

8 Flying Arts is not responsible for participants before they check into, and after they check out of Anglican Church Grammar School (Churchie). Please organise your travel arrangements so that you arrive by 11am on Monday 29 June and leave between 12.30pm and 2pm on Saturday 4 July. Art Camp staff will be at Churchie from 9am Monday 29 June to 2pm Saturday 4 July. Flying Arts' staff are available to discuss transport options and will assist whenever possible however cannot take individual participants to the airport or transit centre etc. Public transport options are available.

9 All personal property should be clearly labelled. It is strongly suggested that participants leave valuables at home and we discourage the bringing of large amounts of money. Whilst all care will be taken, Flying Arts will accept no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property. Any losses should be reported to staff immediately.

10 Participants should pay for personal expenses as Flying Arts will not be responsible.

11 Participants are to dress comfortably and suitably for the workshops and social events. Covered shoes must be worn at all times during workshops and hair should be tied back when using equipment.

12 Respect for the property of Churchie must be shown at all times. Any breakages should be reported to a Flying Arts staff member immediately. Churchie facilities should be left as they were found. If a participant causes any damage to property he/she may be liable to pay for the costs of repairs. It is the participants' responsibility to clean up after themselves and assist the Flying Arts staff and volunteers to keep workshop and accommodation spaces tidy.

13 Only prescribed medication is to be brought to Art Camp. Details of this medication must be provided on the Art Camp Registration Form. On arrival participants must register medication with either a supervising Houseparent or Flying Arts staff member.

All enquiries/problems should be directed to Flying Arts staff. Houseparents are also there to assist participants with their enquiries/problems and general care. Participants who disregard these rules may be sent home at their own cost.
